

**New Hampshire AFL-CIO Endorses Arthur Jillette for State Representative in House Sullivan District 2**

*Workers see support for middle class in Jillette.*

HOOKSETT – The New Hampshire AFL-CIO has endorsed Arthur G. Jillette, Jr., the winner of the Democratic primary for State Representative for House Sullivan District 2.

Mark MacKenzie, President of the New Hampshire AFL-CIO, said, “Arthur Jillette is committed to improving the lives of working families and recognizes government has a role to play in that fight. He supports offering workers paid sick days, equal pay for equal work, and reform that makes quality health care affordable for the middle class. That’s the kind of leadership workers need in the State House.”

The New Hampshire AFL-CIO will contact voters in House Sullivan District 2 to educate them on the proposals Jillette favors that benefit the middle class, union and non-union workers alike.

Jillette is a retired educator who has held elected office and resides in Goshen with his wife, Beatrice. He faces Republican candidate Steve Cunningham in the January 12, 2010 general special election.
